We take tours into extremely remote desert country. There are no facilities of any description unless you call in to an Aboriginal Community, no help apart from your travelling group, buggie all made roads, extremely limited phone service.....

Over the years we have sent loads of information out to people before a trip. Then while on the trip quite a number of participants will be taken by surprise how rough the road conditions are, be it corrugations or narrow scratchy scrub lined tracks. *When you ask if they read all of the pre-trip information they vow & declare they did!*

The other thing that happens is we will talk to them on the phone & discuss how bad the road conditions are & they will tell us how experienced they are in corrugations & old abandoned tracks etc. *Once again, when finally faced with the reality of the western desert "road" network it's astonishment at how bad it all is, or the old favourite, "We didn't know it would be this bad!"*

Keep These Sheets - Tour Spares & Gear for Both Vehicles & Camper Trailers

The following is the most basic list of what vehicles should be carrying for remote travel. If you don't carry spares for your vehicle we can't guarantee we will be able to fix it if you have problems. We only carry spares for our own vehicle and they will be different to yours.

Think about it!!!

UNDER BONNET

WORKSHOP MANUAL FOR VEHICLE IF POSSIBLE

Engine Sensors (late model engines) - seek professional advice

Fan belts, radiator hoses, engine filters; oil, air & fuel (make the filters dust proof)

Engine oil, gear oil, brake/clutch fluid, small tub of grease

Hose clamps, various sizes, radiator repair putty, gasket silicone or similar

Spare electrical relays, fusible links, fuses, 3mm 12V wire, crimp on joiners & terminals

Vehicle jack & large plate (for jacking in soft ground)

Spare shock absorbers, front & rear - extra nuts, bolts, washers & bushes for shocks

TYRE GEAR

2 spare tyres (one tyre can be carried as a carcass)

2 spare tubes to suit

Puncture repair kit, tyre pressure gauge

Tyre levers & bead-breaker

Air compressor

OTHER BITS

Jumper cables, electrical & duct tape, strong glue, nuts, bolts & washers, screws

Snatch strap, ratchet straps, zip ties (ground sheet to work on and do tyre repairs on)

Flyscreen or shade cloth, enough to cover front of vehicle

CAMPER SPARES

Wheel bearings (one set will do), hub seal, spare D shackles for chains

Shock absorber, rubber bushes, washers & nuts

- Coil spring - suspension arm bolts & over-travel strap/chain
- Leaf spring - U bolts, shackle bolts & shackle bushes

Please remember Connie & Mick don't carry spare parts for your vehicle.

Road Condition Warning

During your trip you and your vehicle will face hundreds of kilometres of roads, tracks & wheeltracks. You will be travelling in vast areas that get little or in fact no road maintenance, some of the Beadell Tracks have not seen a grader since the 1980s or even earlier. As well as the "main" roads we will be making detours using overgrown tracks & wheeltracks to see various sites, these have the potential to scratch paintwork on vehicles.

Please be prepared for the conditions listed below

- Corrugations
- wash-outs
- scrub lined tracks
- plenty of dust
