"Sandy Blight to Emu" Tour

"Series in the Scrub" Tour

This will be a two week trip specifically for the older Land Rover models (leaf springs), an opportunity to give the genuine 4WDs a run in the scrub away from the crowded tourist routes. Our time will be spent exploring sites and features of the eastern & southern Nullarbor. If you immediately think of the Nullarbor Plain then you are much mistaken.....

A combination of the famous Len Beadell roads guided by Beadell family historian Connie, of Connie Sue Highway fame, this tour will cover many of Len's roads that run through the more northern deserts areas. The Great Sandy Desert in particular is a vast expanse of vegetated sandhill country nothing like the Hollywood stereotype. Travel with Connie & Mick for a steady informative look at the heart of Australia. An area made unique by Aboriginal culture & explorers from long ago.
