### Tour - Series in the Scrub 2017

This will be a two week trip specifically for the older Land Rover models (leaf springs). The trip will concentrate in the country near Coober Pedy & include travel along the famous Dog Fence. These Land Rover trips are set at a slower pace for the older vehicles and are a relaxed ramble in remote country away from the tourist routes.

### Tour - Anne Beadell & Connie Sue Highways in Full

2017 will be 55 years since the Gunbarrel Road Construction Party completed both the popular Anne Beadell & Connie Sue Highways, made famous in Len's book "Bush Bashers". We will be travelling the full length of both highways in as much detail as possible with special permissions from the Traditional Owners. This will be a special trip with many extras included.

### Expedition (Off-Track travel) - Carnegie, Wells & Hann

An area in the north west of the Great Victoria Desert was criss-crossed by quite a number of the explorers in the early days. Some are well known, others are only known to history buffs & enthusiasts. This year we intend to travel off-track into this area and look for the sites that the explorers noted in their journals. Yet another of our off-track explorations of historical remote country that has been forgotten & bypassed by the current road network in the western deserts.

- Special preparation required
- Split rims & heavy tyres compulsory

### Tour - Beadell Tracks Wanderer

Another combination of the famous Len Beadell roads guided by Beadell family historian Connie, of Connie Sue Highway fame, this tour will cover Len's roads that run through the Little Sandy Desert, Gibson's Desert & the Central Ranges. Join us for a pleasant journey along the Windy Corner Road, Gary Highway and much of the Gunbarrel Highway, including the South Australian section through APY lands. This will be a steady informative look at the hidden heart of Australia. An area made unique by Aboriginal culture & explorers from long ago.
