"Beadell Tracks Wanderer 2024"

We have been looking at reducing our numbers of trips for some years, even before the Covid Response wiped sanity away. Accordingly Connie & Mick will be offering only one trip per year for the foreseeable future.

As usual, the tour is regulated by permit approvals and other possible restrictions.

It's been a while since we included some of Len's more northern network so 2024 will take a wander up north before running south. These north south trips offer the greatest range of environment change in both topography & vegetation.

The trip will start at Yulara Resort head west to Docker River then follow the Sandy Blight Junction Road north. From Sandy Blight Junction head west, deeper into the desert country along the Gary Junction Road. Back into Western Australia we'll visit Kiwirrkurra Community then keep following the sun to Gary Junction. A quick refuel & water top up in Kunawarritji before returning to Gary Junction to run south along the Gary Highway. It's a pretty quiet road without much traffic normally.

A few days later we'll reach Everard Junction on the Gunbarrel Highway. From that isolated spot we'll run west again to Geraldton Bore where we'll take the little used Hunt Oil Road further south to the Great Central Road. Another rest stop for fuel & water at Tjukayirla Roadhouse then back east onto the Parallel Road No.2 which joins the Connie Sue Highway some distance south of Warburton. Once on the Connie Sue we'll make our way to Hann's Track, continuing in country explored by Frank Hann during the early 1900s, to finish our tour in Laverton.
